Registration Procedures

Welcome to the MOW/PRO 2015 Tri State Tour featuring excursions in Oregon, Washington and Idaho. The total mileage for the entire tour is 1131 miles. On page 2 is the list in chronological order of the Railroads we will visit on the MOW/PRO Tri-State Tour. You will have to register for the runs with either MOW or PRO depending on the sponsor and they are indicated on the Work Sheet. Read carefully so you send your money to the proper person. MOW and PRO are requiring their respective paperwork for the runs, so be sure that you have the right forms.

The M O W run fees are indicated on the Worksheet. Check the box for the excursions in which you want to participate. Be careful here so that you are included on the runs you want. Double check your addition and to whom you are sending the money. Make checks payable to MOW and not to the E.C.

We will be spending the night on the rails and away from our autos on four different dates. On September 18, a Friday, we will be in Chehalis, WA and we have a block of rooms being held for us at the Holiday Inn (360) 740-1800. On Friday and Saturday Sept 25 +26 we will be in Joseph, Idaho and we have rooms held so you may choose either the Wallowa Lake Lodge (541) 432-9821 or the Eagle Cap Chalets (541) 432-4704. On Monday Sept 28, we will overnight in Cascade, Oregon and there are rooms held at the Ashley Inn (208) 382-5621. NONE OF THE ROOMS ARE INCLUDED IN YOUR EXCURSION FEE. You need to contact the hotels and reserve your rooms ASAP, especially in Joseph. DON'T WAIT UNTIL September and expect to get a room. I have to release the unsold rooms in the first part of August. To get the group rate tell the motel you are with the Motorcar Operators West group.

After receipt of your check, registration form, and sign-up worksheet, all communication will be by email. You will receive confirmation of your registration upon receipt of your payment. Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Additional information regarding set-on locations, itineraries, lodging and other information will follow as it is confirmed. **Include** with your check the **Sign-up Worksheet**, page 2, with the railroads you wish to run and a **M O W Excursion Participant Registration Form** that you can obtain at www.MOWonline.org . There will be a 30 car limit per railroad on the MOW sponsored excursions.
